1. Choose a “current event” article from one of the journals or websites listed below. The article must relate to a topic or multiple topics from the course.

2. Prepare a 5(ish) minute presentation about your current event.

Your presentation should include the following information:

- Overview of the issue/event.
- How does this event relate to the study of environmental sciences?
- Why is this an important issue?
